

## **Exercise for the Topic Mailing (shortened)**

### **10 points**

Use Thunderbird / Iceweasel in your RISC CBWE account to read your emails at this account.  
(the name of Thunderbird is Iceweasel in Debian Lenny.)

**1.** Create an account in Thunderbird with the following configuration: ( 3 points)

- use the pop3s protocol
- configure the following setting:
  - by the Server Information window unmark the field:  
Use Global Inbox ( store mail in Local Folders)
- set the outgoing mail server to smtpauthhost.risc.uni-linz.ac.at  
(this server needs authentication: your RISC CBWE login and password will be asked, the connection is ssl based)
- send the outgoing emails by Bcc: to your RISC CBWE account
- create the following 4 folders:  
Debian, Networking, Mailing, SSH

**2.** Setup some filters: ( 3 points)

- each email with the subject of a topics (as listed above) has to be moved to the appropriate folder.

Check the setup:

- send at least 4 emails to your RISC CBWE account with the different topic names in the Subject and check, whether the filters work correctly.

Inform me per e-mail, if you finished the above settings, I'll send you some test emails.

**3.** Create five screen shots about the configuration of the email accounts: (4 points)

- a- Thunderbird start page, where I can check the email account and it's folders
- b- account configuration:
  - Account settings <account name>
  - Server Settings
  - Copies and Folders
  - Outgoing Server

4. Copy the five screenshots to your CBWE lecture account (at RISC), into the /home/<yourlogin>/exercises/ mailing directory with the names: iceweasel-start.jpg, iceweasel-account.jpg, iceweasel-server.jpg, iceweasel-folder.jpg, iceweasel-outgoing.jpg
